- Established the first town-wide text reporting system for anti-social behavior-'See Something, Say Something' and in conjunction with Tralee Gardaí a new Business Watch text service is due to be launched this year
- We provide relevant training courses and seminars for our members. 3
 HR Suite Webinars currently running from February
- Promotional opportunities through our tourism marketing platform Visit Tralee.
- Tralee Chamber is the only chamber in Kerry affiliated to Chambers Ireland giving us a recognized voice and influence on lobbying both locally and nationally on behalf of our members.
- We support an extensive events and festivals package for Tralee bringing increased business to the town. For example St Patrick's Festival, Feile Tra Li. Christmas in Tralee
- We have a fully staffed town center office which can assist you with queries.
